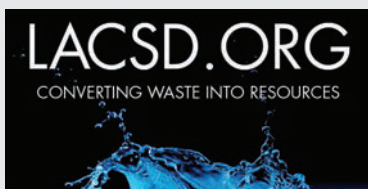

The Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles County (LACSD) provide wastewater and solid waste management for 5.6 million people, and promote environmental sustainability by converting waste to vital resources such as water and energy.

About 20 students are hired each year. Participating students are placed in various sections and come together each week to share their work experience and hear technical presentations from some of LACSD’s over 200 professional engineers. Students may obtain experience in areas such as: recycled water research and production, wastewater and solid waste design and operations, energy recovery, stormwater management, water and air quality, project management, planning and construction.

To be eligible, you must 1) maintain student status through summer or fall enrollment at an ABET accredited Civil/Environmental engineering program during employment; 2) have a strong working knowledge of computers; 3) be available to work full-time for at least 12 weeks during normal business hours in the summer; 4) have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and 5) possess a valid driver’s license issued by a state or territory within the U.S.
