The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) General Pretreatment Regulations for Existing and New Sources of Pollution, 40 CFR Part 403, registre the Sanitation Districts of Co. Sangeless County to publish on an annual basis a list of "Industrial Lasts which, during the previous 12 months, were significantly violating applicable Pretreatment Standards of other Pretreatment Requirements." For the purpose of this provision, significant noncompliance is defined under 40 CFR 403.8 (ft/g2)(vii) and 55 Federal Register 30082 as, (1) Chronic violations in which sixty-six percent or more of all of the measurements taken during a sixmonth period exceed by arriy magnitude the daily maximum, limit or the average limit for the same pollutant parameter., (2) Technical Review Criteria (TRC) violations in which brinty-three percent or more of all the measurements taken during a six-month period equal or exceed the product of the daily maximum limit or the average limit times the applicable TRC (TRC = 1.4 for BOD, TSS, Fats, 0) & Grease, and 1.2 for all other pollutants except phly, (3) Any violation of a pretreatment effluent inflint which alone or in combination with other discharges is determined by the POTW to have caused interference or pase-through, (4) Any discharge of a pollutant that has caused imminent endangement to human health, welfare or to the environment or has resultation the POTW's exercise of its emergency authority to halt or prevent such a discharge, (5) Violations of sumpliance schedule milestones, contained in a local control mechanism or enforcement order by 90 days or more after the schedule date, (6) Failure to provide reports for compliance schedules, self-monthing data, or categorical standards with 45 days of the due date., (7) Failure to accurately report noritompliance, (8) Any violation ry group of violations that the POTW determines will adversely affect the operation or implementation of the contained approved and the POTW determines will adversely affect th
