were no public comments or questions to address the Board on any matters.

Upon motion of Director De Ruse, duly seconded and **RE: MINUTES** unanimously carried, the minutes of the regular meeting

RE: WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT SOUTH WHITTIER OUTFALL RELIEF TRUNK SEWER REHABILITATION PHASE 5 SAK CONSTRUCTION, LLC CONTRACT NO. 5388 ACCEPTANCE OF THE WORK

SAK Construction, LLC, has completed the work in connection with Contract No. 5388 for construction of the South Whittier Outfall Relief Trunk Sewer Rehabilitation Phase 5 (Project) within the time allowed by the contract, and in accordance with its terms. The Project consisted of the rehabilitation of approximately 13,682 feet of 24-inch to 54-inch-diameter corroded reinforced

concrete pipe and appurtenant structures. The work was located in the City of Norwalk and unincorporated Los Angeles County. Four change orders totaling \$1,213,857.30 were approved for this Project. A recommendation was made to accept this work.

Upon motion of Director De Ruse, duly seconded and unanimously carried, the work in connection with Contract No. 5388, entered into by SAK Construction, LLC, on November 12, 2021, for construction of the *South* Whittier Outfall Relief Trunk Sewer Rehabilitation Phase 5, was approved and accepted by this Board of Directors; the Chief Engineer and General Manager was directed to execute and record a Notice of Completion with respect to this work of improvement; and final payment of \$7,801,450.80 was authorized in accordance with the terms of the contract.

RE: SERVICE CHARGE PROGRAM HOLD PUBLIC HEARING ON SERVICE CHARGE REPORT, AND COLLECTION ON TAX ROLL The Chief Engineer and General Manager announced that today the Board would hold a public hearing, and the proposed rate increases associated with the service charge, industrial wastewater surcharge, and connection fee rates, and the collection of the service charge on the

property tax roll were presented. Holding a public hearing and then adopting the Service Charge Report is required each year to collect the wastewater service charge on the property tax roll. The current service charge rate per single-family home is \$15.42 per month (\$185 per year). The rate for fiscal year 2023-24, as previously adopted by the Board of Directors, is \$15.67 per month (\$188 per year). A letter discussing this matter, together with the Service Charge Report, the preliminary budget, and a budget explanation and glossary, accompanies the agenda. This item is consistent with the Districts' Guiding Principles of commitment to fiscal responsibility and prudent financial stewardship; and to plan for both short-term and long-term needs to minimize the need for significant rate increases.

In accordance with Section 5473 of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California, the *County Sanitation District No. 18 Service Charge Report for Fiscal Year 2023-24*, was filed on March 22, 2023, and publication of two newspaper notices for today's public hearing were published in the *Whittier Daily News*, a daily newspaper. The Service Charge Report addresses the continued collection of the service charge for the District on the tax roll. These charges are needed to supplement the District's existing revenue sources for the forthcoming fiscal year, as discussed in the letter to the Boards, dated February 3, 2023.

The Chairperson opened a public hearing on the Service Charge Report for County Sanitation District No. 18 of Los Angeles County. In response to the Chairperson's question, the Secretary reported that the District has received no correspondence or telephone calls on the Service Charge Report.

There being no further comments, the Chairperson closed the public hearing.
