The Personnel Committee is the executive committee that meets with the Chief Engineer and General Manager and staff to discuss and advise on labor negotiations, policy changes, and major projects. In January 2024, labor negotiations will commence for a smaller subset of employee units. Personnel Committee meetings are usually scheduled on the fourth Wednesdays starting at 11:00 a.m. or 12:00 p.m., depending on the number of matters for discussion. There will be meetings scheduled in January through May 2024 to discuss labor negotiations and the budget for Pure Water Southern California.

RE: JOINT ADMINISTRATION PURCHASING POLICY - DEFER

The Chief Engineer and General Manager stated both agendas have an item to consider adoption the proposed revisions to the Purchasing Policy. A letter summarizing

In September 2023, the Personnel Committee, comprised of the Chairpersons of all active Districts, unanimously endorsed the proposed revisions. An issue was raised by Districts Nos. 14 and 20, which are independent from the Joint Outfall System, regarding the approval amount for emergency work. He recommended that the item be deferred until staff resolves the issue.

In response to Director Hahn, District No. 5, the Chief Engineer and General Manager stated that the resolution might consist of additional language related to the approval notice and amount that is specific to Districts Nos. 14 and 20.
