RE: WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT AVENUE H TRUNK SEWER REHABILITATION AWARD CONTRACT NO. 5586 TO INSITUFORM TECHNOLOGIES, LLC ORDER SECRETARY TO EXECUTE

The Avenue H Trunk Sewer Rehabilitation (Project) will consist of rehabilitation of approximately 8,781 feet of 12-inch to 30-inch-diameter corroded concrete pipe and appurtenant structures that were constructed in 1953 and 1967. The work is located within the City of Lancaster as was shown on the map attached to the agenda. The bid

summary/recommendation to award was attached to the agenda. Staff has determined that the Project is exempt or otherwise not subject to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to California Public Resources Code Sections 21080(b)(4) and Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations ("CEQA Guidelines") Section 15301. This item is consistent with the Districts' Guiding Principles to protect financial and facility assets through prudent investment and maintenance programs; and commitment to

operational excellence (protection of public health and the environment, regulatory compliance, and cost effectiveness). The bids received at the District's office on November 9, 2023, for construction of the Project are as follows:

BIDDER TOTAL BID Insituform Technologies, LLC \$3,971,495.00 Southwest Pipeline & Trenchless Corporation \$4,026,604.00 \$4,208,191.00 Sancon Technologies, Incorporated

The bid of Insituform Technologies, LLC, was the lowest bid received and that Insituform Technologies, LLC, was the lowest, regular, responsible bidder for the work, and a recommendation was made to award a contract to Insituform Technologies, LLC, at the unit prices stated in its bid amounting to approximately \$3,971,495. Furthermore, a recommendation was made to order staff to review the insurance and surety bonds for performance and payment and, if sufficient, order the Secretary to execute the contract with Insituform Technologies, LLC, for construction of the Project.

Upon motion of Director Barger, duly seconded and unanimously carried, Contract No. 5586 for construction of the *Avenue H Trunk Sewer Rehabilitation* was awarded to the sole bidder/lowest, regular, responsible bidder, to wit: Insituform Technologies, LLC, at the unit prices stated in its bid amounting to approximately \$3,971,495. Furthermore, the Board of Directors of County Sanitation District No. 14 of Los Angeles County ordered the staff to review the insurance and surety bonds for performance and payment and, if sufficient, ordered the Secretary to execute the contract with Insituform Technologies, LLC, for construction of the Project.

RE: JOINT ADMINISTRATION

The Chief Engineer and General Manager advised that

PURCHASING POLICY - ADOPT

as part of the continuing effort to ensure the Districts follows best practices as it relates to financial matters, revisions to the Purchasing Policy are being recommended. The Districts' Purchasing Policy establishes rules revisions to the Purchasing Policy are being recommended. The Districts' Purchasing Policy establishes rules for purchase of materials, supplies, equipment, services, and construction projects. Proposed revisions to the policy clarify several sections and modify the provisions for emergency orders and contracts. At the November Board meeting, staff was directed to make changes to notification requirements related to emergency actions specified in Section 3.3 to reduce the threshold for Board Chairperson notification and concurrence. The originally proposed threshold was \$500,000 and it was reduced to \$200,000 for all operations outside of the Joint Outfall System. These changes are included in the revised Purchasing Policy that was attached to the agenda. This item is consistent with the Districts' Guiding Principles of commitment to fiscal responsibility and prudent financial stewardship; and to plan for both short-term and long-term needs to minimize the need for significant rate increases. A recommendation was made that the Purchasing Policy be approved and adopted.

The Chairperson pro tem advised Director Barger that last month's item had a \$500k limit and the Board made a motion to defer the item and to come back with a reduction to the limit.

Upon motion of Director Bettencourt, duly seconded and unanimously carried, the Purchasing Policy was considered, approved, and adopted.
