RE: JOINT ADMINISTRATION PURCHASING POLICY - ADOPT

As part of the continuing effort to ensure the Districts follows best practices as it relates to financial matters, revisions to the Purchasing Policy (Policy) are being

recommended. The Policy establishes rules for purchase of materials, supplies, equipment, services, and construction projects. Proposed revisions to the Policy clarify several sections and modify the provisions for emergency orders and contracts. In September 2023, the Personnel Committee, comprised of the Chairpersons

of all active Districts, unanimously endorsed the proposed revisions, and the revised Policy was adopted by this Board at the November 8, 2023, meeting. Subsequently, in response to concerns raised at the November meetings of the District No. 14 and District No. 20 Boards, staff made further revisions to notification requirements related to emergency actions specified in Section 3.3 to reduce the threshold for Board Chairperson notification and concurrence for actions exceeding \$200,000 for smaller Districts. These changes were included in the revised Policy attached to the agenda. This item is consistent with the Districts' Guiding Principles of commitment to fiscal responsibility and prudent financial stewardship; and to plan for both short-term and long-term needs to minimize the need for significant rate increases. A recommendation was made that the Policy be approved and adopted.

Upon motion of Director Jones, duly seconded and unanimously carried by a roll-call vote, the Purchasing Policy was approved, and adopted.

Upon motion of Director Jones, duly seconded and unanimously carried, the meeting was adjourned.
