In addition to incorporation by reference, the impacts for the proposed action and alternatives are summarized in the Executive Summary of the DEIS. For the No-Action Alternative, EPA would not provide grant funding for the Upgrade Project, although the Districts would still be required to construct and operate the facilities for full secondary treatment at the JWPCP to meet the legal objectives of the Consent Decree. Therefore, the impacts of the No-Action Alternative are the same as the impacts of the proposed action and alternatives.
