Allocated expenses represent the District's proportionate share of expenses made by District No. 2, the administrative District, on its behalf pursuant to either the Joint Administration Agreement or the Joint Outfall Agreement. These Agreements provide for the joint administration, technical support and management of the operations, maintenance, and capital costs associated with all of the shared facilities for all of the signatory Districts, along with the methodology for determining the proportionate costs for each District. - 4. Re: Contract with Sancon Engineering, Inc., (Sancon) in Amount of Approximately \$170,590 for Construction of *South Bay Cities Main Trunk Sewer Rehabilitation Between Manholes 30 0044 and 30 0043* (Project)
 - (a) Report on Proposals and Award Contract

<u>Summary</u>: The Project will consist of lining approximately 115 feet of 27-inch-diameter reinforced concrete pipe sewer constructed in 1926. Due to the severely corroded reinforced concrete pipe, rehabilitation of the sewer is considered urgent. The Project is located in the City of Hermosa Beach, as shown on the attached map. Pursuant to authority previously granted by the Board, competitive proposals were solicited from a preselected group of five contractors to expedite completion of the work. The competitive proposal approach shortens the time for design and construction and assures selection of a well-qualified contractor. Sancon was the highest-rated contractor based on cost, approach to the Project,

and ability to perform the work. Staff has determined that the "Project" is exempt or otherwise not subject to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to California Public Resources Code Sections 21080 (b) (4) and 21080.21 and Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations ("CEQA Guidelines") Section 15301. This item is consistent with the Districts' Guiding Principles to protect financial and facility assets through prudent investment and maintenance programs; and commitment to operational excellence (protection of public health and the environment, regulatory compliance, and cost effectiveness).


