RE: SERVICE CHARGE PROGRAM HOLD PUBLIC HEARING ON SERVICE CHARGE REPORT AND COLLECTION ON TAX ROLL The Board was advised that holding a public hearing and then adopting the Service Charge Report is required each year in order to collect the wastewater service charge on the property tax roll. No rate increases are recommended for fiscal year 2021-22. A letter discussing this matter,

together with a copy of the Service Charge Report, preliminary budget, and a budget explanation and glossary, accompanied the agenda. This item is consistent with the Districts' Guiding Principles of commitment to fiscal responsibility and prudent financial stewardship; and to plan for both short-term and long-term needs to minimize the need for significant rate increases.

The service charge rate for fiscal year 2021-22 is \$136 per sewage unit.

In accordance with Section 5473.1 of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California, the *South Bay Cities Sanitation District Service Charge Report for Fiscal Year 2021-22* was filed on March 17, 2021, and publication of two newspaper notices for today's public hearing were published in *The Daily Breeze*, a daily newspaper.

Upon motion of Director Brand, the Chairperson opened a public hearing on the Service Charge Report for South Bay Cities Sanitation District of Los Angeles County. In response to the Chairperson's question, the Chief Engineer and General Manager reported that the District has received no correspondence or telephone calls on the Service Charge Report.

The Chairperson announced this was the time for any presentations by members of the public. There being none, upon motion of Director Zerunyan, the Chairperson closed the public hearing.
